

Reissue Green Card Process

1. Determine Eligibility

- Lost, stolen, or damaged Green Card
- Card contains incorrect information
- Legal name has changed

2. Prepare Form I-90

- Download Form I-90 (Application to Replace Permanent Resident Card) from USCIS website

3. Gather Required Documents

- Current Green Card (if available)
- Personal identification (e.g., passport)
- Supporting evidence for changes (if applicable)

4. Submit Application

- File online or mail the completed Form I-90 with supporting documents
- Pay the required filing fee

5. Attend Biometrics Appointment

- USCIS will schedule you for fingerprinting and a photograph

6. Wait for Processing

- Check case status online

7. Receive New Green Card

- USCIS will mail your new Green Card upon approval
