

Obtaining Certificate of Citizenship through N-600

The **Form N-600** is used to apply for a Certificate of Citizenship. This form is typically for individuals who acquired or derived U.S. citizenship through their parents.

Required Documents

- Completed Form N-600
- Applicant's birth certificate
- Parent's citizenship proof (e.g., Naturalization Certificate or U.S. Passport)
- Marriage certificate of parents (if applicable)
- Evidence of lawful permanent resident status (e.g., Green Card)
- Two passport-style photographs
- Filing fee

Application Process

1. Gather all required documents.
2. Complete and sign Form N-600.
3. Submit your application by mail to the appropriate USCIS address with all the supporting documents and payment.
4. Attend a biometrics appointment if required.
5. Wait for USCIS to make a decision on your application.
